Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has empanelled Access Auditors under Accessible India Campaign;
- (b) whether the Ministry has empanelled Access Auditors under Accessible India Campaign;
- (c) whether the Ministry has invited any applications for empanelling such auditors;
- (d) if so, the criteria for the selections of empanelment of the auditors;
- (e) the names of the organizations from where the applications have been received and the number of applications rejected along with the reasons therefore; and
- (f) whether the criteria conform to international standards?

a) to (b): Yes, Madam. 18 access auditors have been empanelled under Accessible India Campaign. The name of empanelled access auditors is at Annexure-I

(c) to (e): The Government invited proposals with adequate experience and expertise for empanelment of access auditors. The eligibility criteria are as under:-

- i) Minimum two years' experience and expertise of conducting accessibility audit.
- ii) Experience and expertise of conducting accessibility audit of at least 5 government buildings/public infrastructures.
- iii) Only such individual/organization having a good trade record in the field of disability sector. In case of organization, a minimum three year standing as a registered organization in disability sector.

The name of applicant organizations applied for access auditors under Accessible India Campaign is at Annexure -II.

28 application were rejected due to non-fulfillment of documents as per eligibility criteria.

f): Eligibility criteria for access auditors have been framed after consultation with all stake holders.
