- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up an All India Education Service and if so, the details thereof including the plan of its implementation;
- (b) whether the Union Government has held consultations with State Governments for framing the modalities in this regard and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the National Higher Education Promotion and Management Act to replace the existing separate laws governing individual regulators in higher education is proposed to be put in place and if so, the details thereof along with the steps taken in this regard so far;
- (d) whether the Government also proposes to set up a National Accreditation Board; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the time by which it is likely to be operational?

Presently, there are no formal proposals under consideration on the setting up of an All India Education Service, enactment of National Higher Education Promotion and Management Act and the setting up of a National Accreditation Board. However, the Committee for Evolution of the New Education Policy under the Chairmanship of Shri T.S.R. Subramanian has, among other things, made suggestions relating to the creation of an All India Education Service, National Higher Education Promotion and Management Act and National Accreditation Board. The National Policy on Education will be finalised after taking all the points into consideration.
