STATEMENT

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF STARRED QUESTION NO.89 TO BE ANSWERED IN THE LOK SABHA ON 21.12.2017 REGARDING DEENDAYAL UPADHYAYA GRAM JYOTI YOJANA.

(a) to (c) : Under Deendayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY), Government of India have sanctioned 4,503 new projects for 32 States/UTs at a total cost of Rs.42,565.10 crore for various rural electrification works in the country. In addition to this, Rural Electrification (RE) projects with an outlay of Rs. 32,860 crore have been subsumed in DDUGJY. The State-wise progress of DDUGJY new projects, un-electrified villages under DDUGJY and Below Poverty Line households during the last three years is given at Annexure-I, Annexure-II and Annexure-III respectively.

(d) : Funds are released against sanctioned projects in installments based on the reported utilization of amount in the previous installment(s) and fulfillment of other conditionalities including receipt of State contribution, financial sanction for counterpart funding and recommendation of Project Management Agency. The State-wise details of projects sanctioned and funds disbursed under the scheme during the last three years, are given at Annexure-IV and V respectively.
